

ORDINANCE NO. 5163

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as "79-3" to Water District No. 124.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as "79-3" to Water District No. 124 was filed with the County Council September 29, 1980.

2. Water District No. 124 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 320 concurred with the propose annexation.

3. Water District No. 124 filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated July 15, 1980, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 20th day of October, 19 80, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Water District No. 124 of the area known as "79-3" and described in Section 3 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.

1 SECTION 3. The area known as "79-3" to be annexed is
2 described as follows:

3 Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of Grandview
4 Boulevard (57th Avenue South) and the Westerly extension of the
5 North line of Lot 12, Block 146, Plat of Jovita Heights accord-
6 ing to plat thereof recorded in Volume 20 of Plats, pages 12A,
7 12B, 12C, 12D, 12E and 12F, records of King County, Washington;

8 Thence Easterly along said Westerly extension and the
9 North line of said Lot 12 to the Northeast corner thereof;

10 Thence Southerly along the East line of Lots 12 through 14,
11 said Block 146 to the Southeast corner of said Lot 14;

12 Thence Westerly along the South line of said Lot 14 and
13 its Westerly extension to its intersection with the centerline
14 of Grandview Boulevard (57th Avenue South);

15 Thence Northerly along said centerline to the Point of
16 Beginning.
