ORDINANCE NO. 5166

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the establish-  
2 ment of the West leg of NE Tolt Hill  
3 Road (SR 202 to NE Tolt Hill Road)

4 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

5 SECTION 1. The Director of the Department of Public Works  
6 and Transportation has made an examination of West Leg NE Tolt  
7 Hill Road along the course and description set forth below and  
8 has made a favorable report upon the same as required by  
9 RCW 36.81.050.

10 SECTION 2. West Leg of NE Tolt Hill Road shall be estab-  
11 lished not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such  
12 width each side of the following described centerline:

13 Beginning at a point on the centerline of the  
14 Redmond-Fall City Road NE (SR 202) and the inter-  
15 section of the West Leg NE Tolt Hill Road, said  
16 point being S 89°06'35.1"E, a distance of 953.91  
17 feet from the West 1/4 corner of Section 30, Town-  
18 ship 25 North, Range 7 East, W.M., King County,  
19 Washington; thence N 84°06'07.5"E, a distance of  
20 210.79 feet; thence along a tangent curve to the  
21 left having a radius of 130 feet through a central  
22 angle of 52°64' an arc distance of 119.72 feet;  
23 thence N 31°20'07.5" E, a distance of 30.62 feet  
24 to a terminus, said terminus being Station 3+80  
25 NE Tolt Hill Road.
