AN ORDINANCE relating to the establishment of 10th Avenue Southwest (Southwest 336th Way Northeasterly 525.00 feet)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY

SECTION 1. The Director of the Department of Public Works and Transportation has made an examination of 10th Avenue Southwest along the course and description set forth in Section 2 of this ordinance and has made a favorable report upon the same, as required by R.C.W. 36.81.050.

SECTION 2. 10th Avenue S.W. shall be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width on each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at a point on the centerline of 10th Avenue Southwest at its intersection with the centerline of Southwest 336th Way, said point being S 57°03'01"E, a distance of 1,379.49 feet from the Northwest corner of Section 19, Township 21 North, Range 4 East, W.M., King County, Washington; thence N 61°59'41" E, a distance of 525.00 feet to a terminus, said terminus being S 64°19'52" W, a distance of 1,059.75 feet from the North quarter corner of said Section 19.
