ORDINANCE NO. 5192

AN ORDINANCE relating to Council Rules and Order of Business, amending Ordinance 1373, Sections 1, 6, 8, 9, and 15 as amended and K.C.C. 1.24.010, .060, .080, .090 and .150; repealing Ordinance 1373, Sections 2, 16, 18, and 19 and Ordinance 1482, Section 2 and K.C.C. 1.24.020, .160, .170, 180, 190, .200 and .250.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1373, Section 1, as amended and K.C.C. 1.24.010 is hereby amended to read as follows:

ORGANIZATION: (~~The council shall elect a chairman and vice chairman for a term of one year, to begin the second Monday of January of each even-numbered year, at which time the council will reconstitute itself. The chairman and vice chairman/ chairman elect shall serve until the first Monday of January, of each succeeding odd-numbered year, at which time the vice chairman/ chairman elect shall become chairman and the chairman shall become vice chairman. In the temporary absence of the chairman, the vice chairman shall perform the duties and responsibilities of the chairman as imposed by this chapter. In the event the chairman is unable to serve the remainder of the term, the vice chairman shall become chairman. In the event the vice chairman is unable to serve the remainder of the term, a new vice chairman shall be elected.~~) The organization of the council, and such rules and procedures as are deemed appropriate, shall be as prescribed by motion, duly adopted by the council. Any standing rule or order of the council may be rescinded or changed by a majority vote of the members elected.

Provided that:

The proposed change or changes be submitted in writing to the members together with notice of the consideration thereof at least one week in advance.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 1373, Section 6 and K.C.C. 1.24.060 is hereby amended to read as follows:

1 VOTING. There shall be no voting by proxy on any question
2 before the council.

3 Every member within the chambers of the council when the ques-
4 tion is put shall vote (~~(unless the council for special reasons~~
5 ~~shall excuse him. All motions to excuse a member from voting shall~~
6 ~~be made before the call of yeas and nays is commenced and any~~
7 ~~member requesting to be excused from voting may make a brief and~~
8 ~~verbal statement of the reasons for making such request, and the~~
9 ~~question shall then be taken without further debate)).~~

10 (~~(Questions shall be directly put in this form: "All those~~
11 ~~in favor of (as the question may be) say 'Aye', and after the~~
12 ~~affirmative is expressed, "Those opposed say 'No'." If requested~~
13 ~~by any member, the)~~) The individual votes shall be recorded on all
14 questions put to a vote. All votes by the council shall be deemed
15 unanimous unless recorded otherwise in the minutes.

16 SECTION 3. Ordinance 1373, Section 8 as amended, and
17 K.C.C. 1.24.080 is hereby amended to read as follows:

18 INITIAL PROCESSING - ORDINANCES AND MOTIONS. Ordinances and
19 motions shall be drafted in conformance with drafting guidelines
20 prepared by the office of the administrator-clerk of the council.

21 All official communications or requests for council action
22 from the executive or judicial branches addressed to the chairman
23 shall be (~~(assigned a draft number and referred to the appropriate~~
24 ~~committee)~~) considered by the council.

25 SECTION 4. Ordinance 1373, Section 9, as amended, and
26 K.C.C. 1.24.090 is hereby amended to read as follows:

27 INTRODUCTION OF PROPOSED ORDINANCES AND MOTIONS. Upon the
28 signature of at least one member of the council a number shall be
29 assigned to each proposed ordinance or motion. The first reading
30 of a proposed ordinance shall be by title only, unless three
31 members demand reading in full.

32 After the first reading, proposed ordinances shall be referred
33 to committee. Upon being reported back with a recommendation,

1 signed by a majority of the committee, all proposed ordinances
2 shall be placed upon the calendar for public hearing and second
3 reading.

4 SECTION 5. Ordinance 1373 Section 15, as amended, and
5 K.C.C. 1.24.150 is hereby amended to read as follows:


6 LAPSE AND REINTRODUCTION OF ORDINANCES. Draft Ordinances and
7 motions and proposed ordinances and motions which have been intro-
8 duced but not acted upon before the council reconstitutes itself
9 on the second Monday of January shall be deemed to have lapsed if
10 not introduced, reintroduced or acted upon by the council within
11 thirty days from such date. Such ordinance or motion shall bear
12 the same number assigned to it (~~as-when~~) originally
13 (~~introduced~~).

14 SECTION 6. Ordinance 1373, Section 2, 16, 17, 18, and 19
15 as amended, and Ordinance 1482, Section 2, and K.C.C. 1.24.020,
16 .160, .170, .180, .190, .200 and .250 are hereby repealed.


