

ORDINANCE NO. 5193

AN ORDINANCE transferring previously appropriated funds in the amount of \$4,831 to Parks and \$3,865 to Planning from Special Programs to continue planning for a park, recreation, and open space preservation bond program, amending Ordinance No. 4597, Sections 23, 25 and 43 as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a transfer of \$4,831 to Parks and \$3,865 to Planning from the Executive Contingency of Special Programs.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 4597, Section 23 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Parks ((~~\$7,216,389~~)) \$7,221,220

PROVIDED THAT:

- 1) Park Manager I positions shall be phased in pursuant to the following schedule:
 Kenmore District (April 1), Marymoor District (January 1), Wilderness District (July 1), Burbank District (April 1), Angle Lake (January 1), and Steel Lake (July 1).
- 2) Two CETA Utility Worker I positions shall be absorbed June 1 and September 1.
- 3) ~~The-Planner-I-position-and-the-Cartographer-position authorized-to-provide-staff-support-for-a-proposed Parks-and-Open-Space-Bond-Issue-shall-terminate-on September-30,-1980.~~

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 4597, Section 25 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Planning ((~~\$1,718,463~~)) \$1,722,328

PROVIDED THAT:

- 1) ~~The-Planner-I-position-authorized-to-provide-staff support-to-the-Parks-and-Open-Space-Bond-Issue-shall terminate-on-September-30,-1980.~~

The Council intends that:

The Planning Division provide staff support to the Council for METRO and PSCOG issues as requested.

The Planning Division carry out its 1980 work program for the Snohomish/Snoqualmie Resource Management Plan.

SECTION 5. Ordinance No. 4597, Section 43, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Special Programs \$2,939,023

Included in Special Programs is an Executive Contingency of ~~(\$146,492)~~ \$137,796 which shall not be expended unless the County Executive certifies in writing that funds are available and requests that the County Council adopt an additional appropriation ordinance; upon adoption, such funds may be expended for the purpose specified.

PROVIDED THAT:

All provisos adopted by the Council in Ordinance No. 4597, shall be fulfilled.
