ORDINANCE NO. 5202

AN ORDINANCE approving the "Source Amendment" to the Water District 105 Comprehensive Plan (Resolution No. 827)

## PREAMBLE:

On July 21, 1980 Water District 105 adopted Resolution No. 827, which provided for the water source amendment to the district's comprehensive water plan.

On September 15, 1980 Water District 105 filed a Declaration of Non-Significance for the approval of the source amendment.

In July, August, and September, 1980 the Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the source amendment as required by KCC Chapter 13.24, and on September 21, 1980 recommended its approval, making the following findings:

- 1. Current demand exceeds the district's capacity to adequately serve its existing customers (Although recent data contests the finding).
- 2. Numerous development proposals have been accompanied by various descriptions of the district's capacity. This has led to confusion, the continuance and, sometimes, outright denial to several of the proposals.
- 3. Approval of the "Source Amendment" will enable the district to seek and develop new well sites as one means to increase capacity.
- 4. Periodic status reports would enable the County to better advise on the timing for applications to coincide with the increased capacity.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The "Source Amendment" to the Water District 105 Comprehensive Plan, as adopted by Resolution No. 827 (attached) is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. The County has a responsibility to provide the best advice possible on applications to be submitted for its review. To assure that current and accurate information is available at a central location, the district shall provide the Building and Land Development Division with a monthly status report on the

development of its current system and the search for a new well site. Such reports shall continue until the operation of Well E has been verified.
