STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of N.E. 15th Street, hereinafter described.
- 2. The Department of Public Works notified the various utilities serving the area and was advised that easements are not required.
- 3. The Department of Public Works recommends approval of the vacation petition as the vacation area is heavily wooded, difficult to locate, contains a steep cliff and is, in fact, not buildable.
- 4. The vacation area, containing approximately 6,500 square feet, is a portion of the plat of Inglewood, recorded on July 30, 1889. The Department of Public Works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that the County has spent no funds for its acquisition or maintenance. Right of way would, therefore, be classified Class "C" in accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. The Department of Public Works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the County road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due Notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the $24\,\text{Hz}$ day of $19\,80$.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.


