ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to paid parking in the King County Automotive Center and the King County Courthouse, establishing fees and amending Ordinance No. 3976, Section 1, and K.C.C. 3.32.020.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 3976, Section 1, and K.C.C.

3.32.020 are amended to read as follows:

Parking Fees.

a. Parking fees shall be levied against all parking stalls used by vehicles in the King County Automotive Center and the King County Courthouse with the exception of those vehicles exempted from such fees in Section 3.32.030 and the Public Parking Area in Section 3.32.040.

b. Effective January 1 ((1979)) 1981 the Basic Monthly Parking Rate shall be ((~~twenty-five-dollars-per-month~~)) \$35/month.

c. Effective January 1, 1980 the Basic Monthly Parking Rate shall be established by the following method. No more than 90 days prior to January 1st of each calendar year, the Department of Executive Administration shall conduct a survey of the monthly parking rates charged for public parking in all lots of ten or more spaces within the area bounded by Jackson Street on the South, Sixth Avenue on the East, Columbia Street on the North, and Second Avenue on the West. The simple average of these rates, rounded to the nearest whole dollar, shall be reported to the King County Council no less than 60 days prior to January 1st. No less than twenty-one days prior to January 1st the Council shall adopt any change in rates to be effective the following January 1st.

d. All revenues derived from parking fees shall be used to pay:

- (1) Operating expenses, and
- (2) Bond retirement for the garage.
