ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to laboratory services provided by the Seattle-King County Health Department; increase fees; amending Ordinance 2593 and 3393 as last amended by Ordinance 4179 and KCC 2.24.120 and KCC 2.24.125.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Effective January 1, 1981, Ordinance 2593, as last amended by Ordinance 4179 and KCC 2.24.120 is hereby amended as follows:

Laboratory services -- Authorization to charge fees. The Director of the Seattle-King County Department of Public Health is hereby directed and authorized to charge private physicians, private physician clinics, group practices, private laboratories and hospitals for the following laboratory services:

- Rubella Serology (HAI Test).....(~~\$4.75~~) \$7.00
- Rubella Serology (PHA Test).....(~~\$3.00~~) \$3.50
- Gonorrhea Screening Test
(Transgrow Culture)..... \$4.00

SECTION 2. Effective January 1, 1981, Section 2 of Ordinance 3399 as last amended by Ordinance 4179 and KCC 2.24.125 is hereby amended as follows:

Laboratory services -- Family Planning programs. The director is authorized and directed to establish the actual direct and indirect costs of the following laboratory services provided for the department's family planning programs and planned parenthood clinics and community clinics in King County and to charge and collect a fee for such services in the amount indicated:

- Gonorrhea screening test.....(~~\$2.25~~) \$2.55

1 provided that such a fee may be reduced by a subsidy provided to
2 the health department by the Washington State Department of Social
3 and Health Services for gonorrhea-screening family planning
4 programs.
