ORDINANCE NO. 5237

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Council; specifying procedures to be followed by Council members in being reimbursed for actual expenses, or at a per mile rate, for the use of privately owned vehicles used for official travel; adding a new section to K.C.C. 3.28.

PREAMBLE:

K.C.C. 3.28, Compensation for Use of Privately Owned Vehicles, 3.28.010 states: "...The executive, legislative and judicial branches of county government may, at their individual option, establish a system of reimbursement on a monthly allotment basis for use of privately owned vehicles used in connection with county business in lieu of permanently assigned county vehicles...".

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is added to K.C.C. 3.28 a new section to read as follows:

Council members are authorized to be permanently assigned a county vehicle but may at their individual option elect instead to be reimbursed:

- Actual expenses based on a claim for expense displaying costs incurred by date, official activity, receipts of payment; or,
- Expense reimbursed on a set rate per mile, as approved by K.C.C. 3.20.040, based on submission of a claim for expenses. claim to include:
 - Statement of the official activity,
 - 2. Date of the activity,
 - 3, Vehicle license number,
 - 4. Starting and finishing odometer readings,
