

ORDINANCE NO. 5272

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as "Olympic Plain/Park" to Lakehaven Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as "Olympic Plain/Park" to Lakehaven Sewer District was filed with the County Council November 17, 1980.

2. Lakehaven Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 80-802 concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Lakehaven Sewer District filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated October 17, 1980, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 5th day of January, 19 81, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Lakehaven Sewer District of the area known as "Olympic Plain/Park" and described in Section 3 herein is approved. King County Council Annexation Report on "Olympic Plain/Park" is attached and made a part of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.

SECTION 3. The area known as "Olympic Plain/Park" to be annexed is described as follows:



Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of S.W. 342nd street with the Pierce County - King County boundary; Thence Easterly along said centerline to the intersection with the Northerly projection of the Easterly boundary of the Plat of Olympia Plain as shown in Volume 108, Pages 16 and 17, records of King County, Washington; Thence Southerly along the Easterly projection and the Easterly boundary of said plat to the Southeast corner thereof; Thence Westerly along the Southerly boundary of said plat to the intersection with the Pierce County - King County boundary; Thence Northwesterly along said Pierce County - King County boundary to the Point of Beginning; Situated in King County, Washington.
