ORDINANCE NO. 5282

AN ORDINANCE establishing an Affirmative Action Office within the Department of Executive Administration under the direct supervision of the County Administrative Officer.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL:

SECTION1. An Affirmative Action Office is hereby established within the Department of Executive Administration under the direct supervision of the County Administrative Office and with direct accountability to the County Executive.

SECTION 2. The Affirmative Action Office shall have primary jurisdiction over matters concerning discrimination and shall coordinate and implement all King County Affirmative Action Programs including but not limited to the following:

- A. Equal Employment Opportunity Program
- B. Contract Compliance Program
- C. Handicapped Program
- D. Minority/Women Business Program

SECTION 3. Personnel of the Affirmative Action Office shall be employed in accordance with provisions of the Personnel Merit System as established in K.C.C. 3.12, and as outlined under Ordinance 4325 (Administrative Guidelines for Career Service) and

shall include an Affirmative Action Administrator and such support staff as is deemed necessary to carry out the functions of the office.
