

ORDINANCE NO. 5291

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as 80-2 (Squirewood) to King County Water District #105.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as 80-2 (Squirewood) to King County Water District #105 was filed with the County Council December 23, 1980.

2. King County Water District #105 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution #849 concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District #105 filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated December 1, 1980, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 19th day of January, 1981, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District #105 of the area known as 80-2 (Squirewood) and described in Section 3 herein is approved. King County Council Annexation Report on 80-2 (Squirewood) is attached and made a part of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.

SECTION 3. The area known as 80-2 (Squirewood) to be annexed is described as follows:
