ORDINANCE NO. 5303

AN ORDINANCE approving the Comprehensive Water Plan for King County Water District No. 58.

PREAMBLE:

On June 10, 1980, King County Water District No. 58 enacted Resolution No. 1916, and adopted its Comprehensive Water Plan, dated 1980.

On June 10, 1980, Water District No. 58 filed a final Declaration of Non-Significance for the approval of the Comprehensive Water Plan.

On October 27, 1980, the proposed Comprehensive Water Plan was submitted for review by the Utilities Technical Review Committee, as required by KCC 13.24. On December 10, 1980, the Committee recommended that it be approved by the Council.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Water District No. 58 Comprehensive Water Plan, dated 1980 (attached), is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. Distribution system improvements shall be designed in accordance with standards detailed in the plan (Chapter 5), Chapter 17.08 KCC, and DSHS regulations, and shall not require further additions and betterments to the plan.
