ORDINANCE NO. 5311

AN ORDINANCE approving the "Woodinville Senior High School DE 80-10" Additions and Betterments to the Water District 104 Water Comprehensive Plan (Resolution No. 1097).

PREAMBLE:

On September 3, 1980, Water District 104 adopted Resolution No. 1097, which provided for the "Woodinville Senior High School DE 80-10" additions and betterments to the district's water comprehensive plan.

This additions and betterments is exempt from the requirements of the State Environmental Policy Act.

On September 24, 1980, the proposed additions and betterments was submitted to the Utilities Technical Review Committee for review as required by KCC Chapter 13.24. The submittal was incomplete in content and detail. The required information was submitted on October 23, 1980. On November 12, 1980, the Committee recommended its approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The "Woodinville Senior High School DE 80-10" additions and betterments to the Water District 104 Water Comprehensive Plan, as adopted by district Resolution No. 1097 (attached) is hereby approved.
