ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to zoning; establishing a new zone classification known as RMHP (Residential Mobile Home Park); and adding a new chapter to Title 21.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purposes of the RMHP classification and its application area:

- 1. To provide a suitable living environment within a parklike atmosphere for families residing in mobile homes;
- 2. To encourage variety in housing styles within areas otherwise designated for single family residential development by permitting mobile home parks at the approximate density allowed in the surrounding area;
- 3. To permit flexibility in the placement of mobile homes on a site in order to minimize costs associated with development of roads, utilities, walkways, and parking facilities, while providing adequate common and private open space;
- SECTION 2. Location. The RMHP classification shall be applied only in areas:
- a. which are within a Local Service Area as designated by the Sewerage General Plan, and which are served by adequate roads and public water supply;
- b. which have a high level of such public services as public transit, schools, fire and police protection, and solid waste disposal;

c. which are predominantly free of natural features posing potential problems for development, or having important environmental features such as steep slopes, unstable soils, wetlands or floodplains.

## SECTION 3. Permitted uses.

- 1. Mobile home parks;
- 2. Mobile homes, located only within an approved mobile home park;
  - 3. Accessory structures, as provided in Chapter 21.08;
- 4. Recreational facilities, located within and primarily for use of residents of an approved mobile home park;
- 5. Recreational vehicle and boat storage facilities, located within and limited to use by residents of an approved mobile home park only;
  - 6. Home occupation, as provided in Section 21.08.025 (11);
  - 7. Signs, as provided in Section 21.08.030 (8);
  - 8. Day hurseries, as provided in Section 21.08.040 (3).

SECTION 4. The number of mobile homes permitted in a mobile home park shall not exceed one and one-half times the surrounding single family neighborhood density or nine units per gross acre whichever is less. In reclassifying property to RHMP, the County Council may limit density further to assure compatibility with the surrounding residential area or avoid overloading public utilities or services.

## SECTION 5. Limitations.

- 1. All mobile home parks located within the RHMP classification shall be designed and developed in accordance with the standards and procedures set forth in Ordinance 5316, subject to approval by the Building and Land Development Division;
- 2. Every mobile home located in this classification shall comply with the standards and permit requirements set forth in Ordinance 5318.

3. Any accessory structure in excess of one hundred-twenty 1 (120) square feet of floor area or roof area shall be subject to 2 the provisions of the Uniform Building Code as adopted in King 3 County, and a building permit shall be required before construction or installation. SECTION 6. Site area. The minimum site area for a mobile 6 home park shall be three (3) acres. 7 SECTION 7. Area coverage.
