ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE establishing the Seelye Connection Construction Fund and making an appropriation of \$102,854 from the Wastewater Sewer Operation and Maintenance unencumbered fund balance in the amount of \$52,854 and from METRO in the amount of \$50,000; amending Ordinance 5236, Sections 72 and 73, attachment No. 1, as amended.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. The Seelye Sewer Connector in the King County operated Skyway Sewer District has ruptured creating an emergent public health situation requiring immediate correction action.
- 2. The King County Public Works Department is in the process of preparing a Comprehensive Sewer Plan for the Skyway Sewer District.
- 3. The area served by the proposed Seelye Connection Sewer project is within a local service area established in the King County Sewerage General Plan.
- 4. The Utilities Technical Review Committee (U.T.R.C.) has not reviewed the Comprehensive Sewer Plan but will consider this project at its March 11, 1981 meeting.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

NEW SECTION. SECTION 1. There is hereby established a new fund entitled "Seelye Connection-Skyway Sewer District Construction Fund".

NEW SECTION. SECTION 2. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation in the amount of \$102,854 to the Seelye Connection-Skyway Sewer District Construction Fund from the Wastewater Sewer Operation and Maintenance unencumbered Fund balance in the amount of \$52,854 and from METRO in the amount of \$50,000.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 5232, Section 72, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the (~~Sewer-District-Fund~~) Wastewater Sewer Operation and Maintenance Fund there is hereby appropriated:

(~~\$451,022~~) \$503,876

PROVIDED THAT:

All provisos adopted by the Council in Ordinance 5232, as amended, shall be fulfilled.
