AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of 10th Avenue South Petitioner: Harry E. Orris and Others

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of 10th Avenue South, hereinafter described.
- The Department of Public Works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements have been obtained by Puget Sound Power and Light Company and Water District No. 75.
- 3. The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- The vacation area is a portion of the plat of the Grove Addition to the Town of Des Moines which was recorded on January 17, 1890. The Department of Public Works has found no evidence that the vacation area was ever opened as a road and a search of the records indicates that County funds were not spent for its acquisition or maintenance. Right of way would, therefore, be classified "C Class" in accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. The Department of Public Works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the County road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the 23rd day of March

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Council on the 23rd day of March , 19 8 hereby vacates and abandons the portion of 10th Avenue South, described as follows:
