ORDINANCE NO. 5430

AN ORDINANCE approving the "Woodinville Business Center One" Additions and Betterments to the Water District 104 Water Comprehensive Plan (Resolution No. 1166).

PREAMBLE:

On February 17, 1981, Water District 104 adopted Resolution No. 1166 which provided for the "Woodinville Business Center One" Additions and Betterments to the District's Water Comprehensive Plan.

A Declaration of Non-Significance for the proposed Additions and Betterments was adopted by the District on February 17, 1981 (Resolution No. 1167).

On March 12, 1981, the proposed Additions and Betterments were submitted to the Utilities Technical Review Committee as required by Chapter 13.24 K.C.C. On April 8, 1981 the UTRC recommended approval of these Additions and Betterments.
