AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known. as Kofal to Water District No. 111.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Kofal to Water District No. 111 was filed with the County Council April 13, 1981.
- 2. Water District No. 111 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 161-2-81 concurred with the proposed annexation.
- 3. Water District III filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated March 19, 1981, on the proposed annexation.
- 4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 1876 day of , 19 <u>//</u>, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Water District 111 of the area known as Kofal and described in Section 3 herein is approved. King County Council Annexation Report on Kofal is attached and made a part of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.

SECTION 3. The area known as Kofal to be annexed is described as follows:

That portion of Sections 22 and 23, Township 22 North, Range 5 East, W.M., described as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of said Section 23;

Thence Easterly along the North line of said Section 23 to its intersection with the East line of the West 1/2 of the West 1/2 of said Section 23;

Thence Southerly along said East line to its intersection with the South line of the North 300 feet of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of said Section 23;

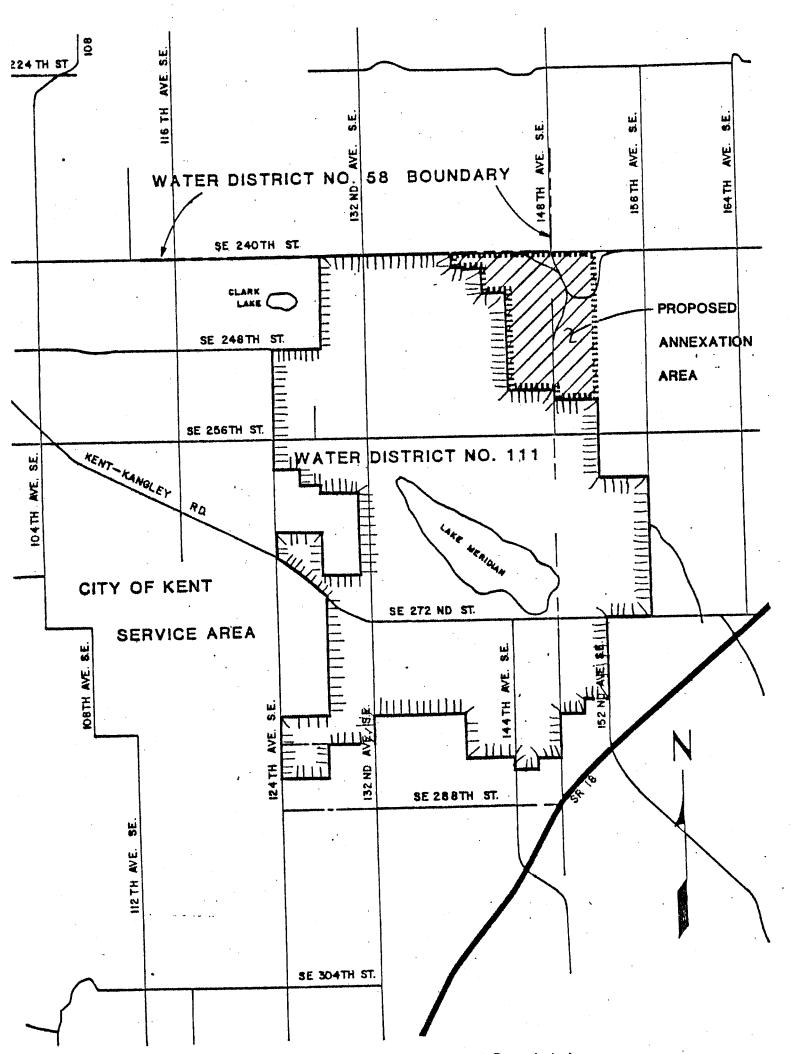
