STATEMENT OF FACTS

- A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of
 S.W. 369th Street, hereinafter described.
- 2. The Department of Public Works notified the various utilities serving the area and was advised that easements are not required.
- 3. The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. The vacation area is a portion of the plat of East Tacoma, King County, Washington, recorded December 2, 1889. A search of the records indicates that the County has spent no funds for its acquisition or maintenance. Right of way would, therefore, be classified 'C Class' in accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. The Department of Public Works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the County road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.
