ORDINANCE NO. 5567

AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to approve in part, subject to conditions the application for TIMBERLAND DESIGNATION petitioned by JOHN A. MULLEN and designated File No. 202-80-S

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Ordinance does hereby adopt and incorporate herein the findings and conclusions contained in the report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner dated June 3, 1981, filed with the Clerk of the Council on July 1, 1981, recommending action upon the application of JOHN A. MULLEN, for TIMBERLAND DESIGNATION described in Building and Land Development File No. 202-80-S.

SECTION 2. The recommendation by the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to approve in part, subject to conditions, is hereby adopted by the Council of King County. Those conditions, if any, which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied within one year of Council approval, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect. Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the Building and Land Development Division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
