

ORDINANCE NO. 5591

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation in the amount of \$586,037 to the Grant Fund from a State of Washington Referendum 37 grant award; for an Alcohol Transition Residence, Capital Improvement Project No. 004075; amending and revising the 1981 Capital Improvement Budget and Program, amending Ordinance No. 5232, Section 73, Attachment No. 1, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation in the maximum amount of \$586,037 to the Grant Fund from a State of Washington Referendum 37 grant award, for the purpose of acquiring, renovating, and equipping a transitional residence for recovering alcoholics, the Alcohol Transition House, Capital Improvement Project No. 004075.

SECTION 2. The project information sheet attached hereto is adopted to amend and revise the 1981 Capital Improvement Budget and Program, amending Ordinance No. 5232, Section 73, Attachment No., as amended.




