

ORDINANCE NO. 5608

1 AN ORDINANCE concurring with the Recommendation of the
2 Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County
3 Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying
4 certain property upon the application of JAMES
5 HARTWELL, designated Building and Land
6 Development File No. 203-81-R.

7 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

8 SECTION 1. This Ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and
9 conclusion of the July 22, 1981 report of the Zoning and Subdivision
10 Examiner, filed with the Clerk of the Council on August 6, 1981,
11 on the application of JAMES HARTWELL to reclassify
12 certain property described in Building and Land Development File No. 203-81-R.

13 SECTION 2. The recommendation by the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to
14 reclassify the subject property from SR (Potential RD-3600)
15 to RD-3600-P in lieu of RM-2400 is hereby adopted by
16 the Council of King County. Those conditions, if any, which must be
17 satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied within
18 one year of Council approval, or all authority granted by this ordinance
19 shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect. (If
20 none, the effective date shall be ten days after enactment.) Upon this
21 ordinance becoming effective, the Building and Land Development Division shall
22 amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
