

ORDINANCE NO. 5618

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as "Dumas Bay #2" to Lakehaven Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as "Dumas Bay #2" to Lakehaven Sewer District was filed with the County Council July 17, 1981.

2. Lakehaven Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 81-847 concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Lakehaven Sewer District filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated May 26, 1981, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 17th day of August, 19 81, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Lakehaven Sewer District of the area known as "Dumas Bay #2" and described in Section 3 herein is approved. King County Council Annexation Report on "Dumas #2" is attached and made a part of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.

SECTION 3. The area known as "Dumas Bay #2" to be annexed is described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Section 10, Township 21 North, Range 3 East, W.M., in King County, Washington; Thence South 89°51'42" West along the South line thereof, 554.34 feet;

Thence North 00°16'00" West parallel to the East line of said Section 10 to the Southerly margin of Ingram Drive as it now exists 30.00 feet in width;
Thence Northeasterly along said Southerly margin of Ingram Drive to a point of intersection with the East section line of said Section 10;
Thence Southerly along said East section line to the Southeast corner of said Section 10 and the Point of Beginning.

Situate in the County of King, State of Washington.


