## ORDINANCE NO. 5627

AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of 96th Avenue N.E. Petitioner: Charles Henderson and Others V-1720

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of 96th Avenue N.E., hereinafter described.
- 2. The Department of Public Works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that an easement has been obtained by Northeast Lake Washington Sewer & Water District.
- 3. The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation. They recommended, however, that consideration should be given to the inclusion of that portion of 96th Avenue N.E., from N.E. 120th Street northerly to the subject proposed vacation in order that the entire section of street be vacated.
- 4. The Department of Public Works agrees with the recommendation of the Division of Building and Land Development and following approval by Petitioner Henderson, revised the description of the vacation area.
- 5. The Real Property Division concurs with the Department of Public Works and therefore submits the vacation request as revised.
- 6. The vacation area was deeded to King County for a road and was recorded under Auditor's File No. 6601870 on December 23, 1969, Records of King County, Washington. A search of the records indicates that the County has spent no funds for its acquisition or maintenance. Right of way would, therefore, be classified "C" class in accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759.
