AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of 55th Avenue South

Petitioner: Hillis Homes, Inc. and others

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of 55th Avenue South, hereinafter described.
- The Department of Public Works has notified the various utilities 2. serving the area and has been advised that easements were not required.
- 3. The Division of Building & Land Development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that the vacation was recommended as a condition for final approval of the preliminary subdivision of Hillis Hills (File #77-22). As such, this Division would have no objection to the proposed vacation.
- The vacation area is a portion of James C. Campbell County Road 4. No. 395, deeded to King County on July 13, 1894, and said deed was accepted by the County Commissioners on September 10, 1894, at no expense to the County. The Department of Public Works has found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been opened as a road. A search of the records indicates that the County has spent no funds for its acquisition or maintenance. Right of way would, therefore, be classified "C Class" in accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759. The subject area contains approximately 26,400 square feet.
- The Department of Public Works considers the remaining subject right of way useless as part of the County road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the 24th day of august, 198/.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
