AN ORDINANCE approving the Water Comprehensive Plan for the Maury Mutual Water Company, dated 1981.

PREAMBLE:

On March 18, 1981, the Maury Mutual Water Company Water Comprehensive Plan was submitted for review by the Utilities Technical Review Committee, as required by KCC Chapter 13.24.

On June 15, 1981, the Committee recommended its approval after having made the following findings:

8

1. The Company is legally obligated to provide water service to 99 connections for which it has sold "subscriptions."

10

2. The system should be designed with 99 connections as the criteria for minimum design standards.

3. The system's existing source capacity does not satisfy the minimum design standards of DSHS and King County for 99 connections of 68.75 gpm.

13

4. The comprehensive plan's proposed increase in source capacity to 58 gmp is inadequate to satisfy minimum design standards for 99

connections.

5. The system's existing 52,000 gallon storage capacity does not

16

satisfy minimum design standards of DSHS and King County for 99 connections which require 129,000 - 137,000 gallons of storage.

6. The comprehensive plan's proposed increase in storage capacity (to 106,500 gallons) is inadequate to satisfy minimum design standards.

7. The system's existing distribution facilities are inadequate to satisfy the fire flow standards of DSHS and King County.

8. The comprehensive plan proposes a long-term program of water main installation and replacement, together with fire hydrants.

9. The existing system does not have an emergency power source, and, consequently, cannot provide a reliable water supply.

10. The comprehensive plan does not provide an emergency power

11. The system's existing service extends to two "subscribers" beyond the boundary of the Company's franchise.

On July 1, 1981, King County issued a Final Declaration of Non-Significance for the approval of the Maury Mutual Water Company Water Comprehensive Plan.
