ORDINANCE NO. 5636

AN ORDINANCE approving the Water Comprehensive Plan for Water District No. 94.

PREABMLE:

On May 6, 1981, Water District 94 adopted Resolution No. 81-5-6A which approved the water comprehensive plan.

On May 6, 1981, Water District 94 filed a Final Declaration of Nonsignificance for the approval of the water comprehensive plan.

On April 30, 1981, the proposed water comprehensive plan was submitted to the Utilities Technical Review Committee for review as required by KCC Chapter 13.24. On June 12, 1981, the Committee recommended that it be approved after making the following findings:

- 1. The system's existing storage capacity meets the minimum design standards of DSHS and King County.
- The existing system does not have an emergency power source, and, consequently, cannot provide a reliable water supply.
- 3. The district lacks the funds to implement the necessary improvements.
- 4. The comprehensive plan proposes that the existing rates be reviewed with the intent to insure that adequate revenue is available to implement system improvements.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Water District 94 Water Comprehensive Plan, dated 1981, is hereby approved subject to the following conditions:

a. The district shall submit to the Utilities Technical Review Committee, by December 31, 1981, the results of the rate review together with an explanation on how the new rates will finance the system improvements of the plan.

3	system to make it reliable. These improvements may include:
4	1) an intertie with adjacent water system(s); or 2) an
5	emergency power source.
