An Ordinance relating to a proposed amendment of Article V, Section 560, King County Charter concerning Political Activities of County Employees, submitting same to the voters of the County and establishing date of election.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

. <u>SECTION 1</u>. There shall be submitted to the qualified voters of King County for their approval and ratification or rejection, at the next general election to be held in this county, an amendment to Article V, Section 560 of the King County Charter:

AMENDING Section 560 to read as follows:

560 POLITICAL ACTIVITIES

The political activities of county employees and offices shall be governed by the applicable provisions of state law.

A-member-of-the-career-service-may-be-elected-and-serve-as-a precinct-committeeman-without-violating-the-provisions-of-this section:--A-member-of-the-career-service-may-file-for-a-compensated-elective-office;-but-he-shall-take-and-be-granted-a-leave of-absence-until-the-date-of-the-election.

SECTION 2. The director of the Division of Records and Elections shall cause notice of the proposed amendment of the King County Charter to be published in accordance with the State
