

ORDINANCE NO. 5681

AN ORDINANCE establishing the date for an election on the question of formation of a park and recreation district in the vicinity of Issaquah, Washington, repealing Ordinance 5645, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to R.C.W. 36.69.020, a petition requesting formation of a park district with boundaries coterminous with the Issaquah School District has been certified by the Records and Elections Division.

SECTION 2. The name of the proposed park and recreation district shall be King County Park and Recreation District No. 2.

SECTION 3. At the general election to be conducted on November 3, 1981, the proposition of formation of a park and recreation district shall be submitted to the qualified electors residing within the proposed district as hereinafter described. The proposition shall be substantially in the following form:

Shall King County Park and Recreation District No. 2 with boundaries and subdivisions as fully described in King County Ordinance No. _____ be created.

SECTION 4. The Boundaries of the proposed park and recreation district are described as follows:

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1 Beginning at the point of intersection of the north line of
2 Sec. 6, Twp. 24N, R6E and the shore of Lake Sammamish, thence
3 east to the NE corner of Sec. 1, Twp. 24N, R6E; thence south to
4 the NW corner of Sec. 19, Twp. 24N, R7E; thence east to the NE

6 Sec. 19, Twp. 24N, R7E; thence east to the SW corner of the SE
7 1/4 of Sec. 20, Twp. 24N, R7E; thence north to the NW corner of
8 the SE 1/4 of said Sec. 20; thence east to the NE corner of the
9 SE 1/4 of said Sec. 20; thence south to the SE corner of the
10 SE 1/4 of said Sec. 20; Twp. 24N, R7E; thence east to the NE
11 corner of Sec. 28, Twp. 24N, R7E; thence south to the NW corner
12 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 34, Twp. 24N, R7E; thence east to the NE
13 corner of the SW 1/4 of said Sec. 34; thence south to the SE
14 corner of the SW 1/4 of said Sec. 34; Twp. 24N, R7E; thence east
15 to the NE corner of Sec. 3, Twp. 23N, R7E; thence south to the
16 NW corner of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 2, Twp. 23N, R7E; thence east to
17 the NE corner of the SW 1/4 of said Sec. 2; thence south to the

19 corner of Sec. 12, Twp. 23N, R7E; thence south to the SE corner

21 Sec. 16, Twp. 23N, R7E; thence south to the SE corner of Sec. 21,
22 Twp. 23N, R7E; thence west to the NE corner of Sec. 30, Twp. 23N,
23 R7E; thence south to the SE corner of said Sec. 30; thence west
24 to the SW corner of said Sec. 30, thence south to the SE corner
25 of Sec. 36, Twp. 23N, R6E; thence west to the SW corner of said
26 Sec. 36; thence north to the NW corner of said Sec. 36; thence
27 west to the NE corner of Sec. 33, Twp. 23N, R6E; thence south to
28 the corner of the NE 1/4 of said Sec. 33; thence west to the SW
29 corner of the NW 1/4 of said Sec. 33; thence north to the SE
30 corner of the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of said Sec. 29; thence west to the SW
31 corner of the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of said Sec. 29; thence north
32 to the SE corner of the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said Sec. 29;
33 thence west to the SW corner of the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said
Sec. 29; thence north to the center east-west section line of
Sec. 20, Twp. 23N, R6E; thence west to the SW corner of the NW
1/4 of said Sec. 20; thence north to the SE corner of the NE 1/4
of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 19, Twp. 23N, R6E; thence west to the SW
corner of the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 24, Twp. 23N, R5E;
thence south 100'; thence west 316.68'; thence south to the
intersection with J.E. Jones Road Revised; thence westerly along
J.E. Jones Road Revised to the intersection with the west line of
Sec. 24, Twp. 23N, R5E, except for the portion lying within the
west 628.30' of the south 355' thereof; thence north to the NW
corner of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 24, Twp. 23N, R5E;
thence west to 158th Ave SE extended in Sec. 23, Twp. 23N, R5E;
thence north along said 158th Ave. SE to its intersection with
the east-west centerline of the N 1/2 of Sec. 14, Twp. 23N, R5E;
thence west to the SW corner of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said
Sec. 14; thence north to the NW corner of said Sec. 14; thence
west to the SW corner of the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 10, Twp.
23N; R5E; thence north to the NW corner of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 3,
Twp. 23N, R5E; thence west to the SW corner of the SE 1/4 of the
SW 1/4 of Sec. 34, Twp. 24N, R5E; thence north to the NW corner
of the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of said Sec. 34; thence west to the
intersection with the Newcastle Rd.; thence northwesterly along
the centerline of Newcastle Road to its intersection with the
east-west centerline of Sec. 34, Twp. 24, R5E; thence west to the

1 SW corner of the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 33, Twp. 24N, R5E;
 2 thence north to the intersection with SE 69th - SE 72nd St.;
 3 thence southeasterly along the centerline of the SE 69th - SE 72nd
 4 St. to its intersection with Coal Creek Parkway SE; thence north
 5 along the centerline of Coal Creek Parkway SE to its intersection
 6 with the north line of Sec. 28, Twp. 24N, R5#; thence east to
 7 the SW corner of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 23, Twp. 24N, R5E; thence
 8 north to the NW corner of the SE 1/4 of said Sec. 23; thence
 9 east to the SW corner of the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of said Sec. 23
 10 thence north to the NW corner of the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of
 11 Sec. 14, Twp. 24N, R5#; thence east to the center of interstate
 12 90; thence southeasterly along said center line to its inter-
 13 section with the north-south centerline of Sec. 13; Township
 14 24N; R5E; thence north to the shoreline of Lake Sammamish;
 15 thence southerly, easterly, and northerly along the shoreline of
 16 Lake Sammamish to its intersection with the N. line of Sec. 6,
 17 Twp. 24N, R6E, the true point of beginning - all situated in
 18 King County, Washington.

19 The below described property is deleted from the proposed district

- 20 (1) Beginning at the point of the northerly intersection of the
 21 west line of Sec. 16, Twp. 24N, R6E and the shore of Lake
 22 Sammamish; thence North to the intersection of Lake Sammamish
 23 Parkway SE; thence southeasterly along the centerline of
 24 Lake Sammamish Parkway SE to the intersection of SR-90;
 25 thence northwesterly along the centerline of SR-90 to the
 26 intersection of the west line of Sec. 20, Twp. 24N, R6E;
 27 thence northerly along said west line of Sec. 20 to the
 28 shore of Lake Sammamish; thence southeasterly and north-
 29 easterly along the shore of Lake Sammamish to the true
 30 point of beginning - all situated in King County, Washington.
- 31 (2) Beginning on the west shore of Lake Sammamish 1030 feet
 32 S of N line GL 1 in Section 12, Twp 24 N, R5E; thence
 33 westerly to the centerline of West Lake Sammamish Parkway SE,
 (a point 1030 feet S of the N line of Section 12, Twp 24 N,
 R5E); thence northerly along said centerline to its inter-
 section with the centerline of SE 26th Street; thence
 northwesterly along the centerline of SE 26th Street to its
 intersection with the NS centerline of the W 1/2 of said
 Section 12; thence S to the SE corner of the NW 1/4 of the
 NW 1/4 of Section 12, Twp 24 N, R5E; thence W to the SW
 corner of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4, Section 12, Twp 24 N,
 R5E; thence S to the N margin of PS Highway No. 2 SR-90;
 thence southeasterly along the N margin of PS Highway No. 2,
 SR-90 to its intersection with the E line of the NW 1/4
 of Section 13, Twp 24 N, R5#; thence N along the E line of the
 NW 1/4 of Section 13, Twp 24 N, R5E, and the E line of the
 SW 1/4 of Section 12, Twp 24 N, R5E, to its intersection
 with the centerline of West Lake Sammamish Parkway SE;
 thence northwesterly along the center line of West Lake
 Sammamish Parkway SE to its intersection with the N line
 GL 4 in said Section 12; thence easterly along the N line
 GL 4, Section 12, Twp 24 N, R5E to the shore of Lake
 Sammamish; thence northerly along the shore of Lake
 Sammamish to its intersection with the S line of the N
 1030 feet, Section 12, Twp 24 N, R5E, the true beginning
 point, all situated in King County, Washington.

1 SECTION 5. The boundaries of the five subdivisions within
2 the park and recreation district shall be the same as the five
3 Issaquah School District Director Districts, and are described
4 as follows:

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6 Commissioner District #1; Sections 24, 25, 26, 27, 35,
7 36 and those portions of 1, 12, 13, 14, 23, 28, and 33 lying with-
8 in the Issaquah School District, together with that portion of
9 Section 34 lying within the Issaquah School District north of
10 the May Creek Road, all lying within Township 24N, R5E, W.M.;
11 together with Sections 18, 19, 30, 31 and that portion of
12 Sections 20, 29, and 32 lying west of Newport Way and the
13 Renton/Issaquah Road S.E., all within Township 24N, R6E, W.M.;
14 together with Section 1 and those portions of Section 2 and 12
15 lying north of the May Creek Road, all lying within Township 23N,
16 R5E W.M.; together with those portions of Sections 5, 6 and 7
17 lying northwest of the Renton-Issaquah Road, all within Township
18 23N, R6E, W.M.

19 In general, Commissioner District #1 includes the Sunset
20 and Cougar Mountain areas. The north and west boundaries
21 coincide with the School District boundary. The east boundary
22 is the center line of Lake Sammamish to extension of 196th S.E.
23 to Newport Way and the Issaquah-Renton Road. The south boundary
24 is the May Creek Road.

25 Commissioner District #2: That portion of Section 34,
26 Township 24N, R5E, W.M. within the Issaquah School District south
27 of the May Creek Road together with Sections 11, 13 and those
28 portions of Section 3, 10, 14, 23 and 24 within the Issaquah
29 School District and that portion of Sections 2 and 12 lying south
30 of the May Creek Road, all lying within Township 23N, R5E, W.M.;
31 together with the western 1/4 of Section 18 and the western 1/4
32 of the portion of Section 19 lying within the Issaquah School
33 District, all lying within Township 23N, R6E, W.M.

 In general, Commissioner District #2 includes the Briarwood
and Apollo areas. The north boundary is the May Creek Road.
The east boundary is 180th S.E. from May Creek Road to the S.E.
128th, 1/4 mile east to 184th S.E. to the School District boundary
line. The south and west boundaries coincide with the School

1 District boundary.

2 Commissioner District #3: Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8,
3 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, those portions of Sections 20,
4 21, and 28 north of I-90 and the western $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 22, all
5 within Township 24N, R6E, W.M.; except for that property
6 described as follows: "Beginning at the point of the northerly
7 intersection of the west line of Sec. 16, Twp. 24N, R6E and the
8 shore of Lake Sammamish; thence North to the intersection of
9 Lake Sammamish Parkway SE; thence southeasterly along the center-
10 line of Lake Sammamish Parkway SE to the intersection of SR-90;
11 thence northwesterly along the centerline of SR-90 to the
12 intersection of the west line of Sec. 20, Twp. 24N, R6E; thence
13 northerly along said west line of Sec. 20 to the shore of Lake
14 Sammamish; thence southwesterly and northeasterly along the shore
15 of Lake Sammamish to the true point of beginning - all situated
16 in King County, Washington.

17 In general, Commissioner District #3 includes the Pine Lake
18 and Sunny Hills areas. The north and east boundaries coincide
19 with the School District boundary. The west boundary is the
20 center line of Lake Sammamish to extension of 196th S.E. and south
21 to I-90. The south boundary is I-90 from the west district
22 boundary to the Issaquah Interchange, then north and east passing
23 east of Overdale Park to S.E. 148th and thence east to the School
24 District boundary.

25 Commissioner District #4: Sections 19, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32,
26 33 and those portions of 20 and 34 within the Issaquah School
27 District, all lying within Township 24N, R7E, W.M., together
28 with Sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20,
29 21, 30 and that portion of Section 2 within the Issaquah School
30 District, all lying within Township 23N, R7E, W.M.; together
31 with Sections 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 21, 22, 23,
32 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 36, and those portions of Sections 20, 29, and
33 33 lying within the Issaquah School District as well as the
34 eastern $\frac{3}{4}$ of Section 18 and the eastern $\frac{3}{4}$ of that portion of
35 Section 19 within the Issaquah School District, together with
36 the portion of Sections 6 and 7 southeast of the Renton-Issaquah
37 Road, all lying within Township 23N, R6E, W.M.

38 In general, Commissioner District #4 includes Maple Hills,
39 Mirrormont, Tiger Mountain and the Preston areas. The south and
40 east boundaries coincide with the School District boundary. The
41 west boundary coincides with the east boundary of Commissioner
42 District #2. The north boundary, moving from west to east is the
43 Issaquah-Renton Road, south on 196th Avenue S.E. to S.E. 112th
44 westward to 276th Avenue S.E. and from there north to the District
45 boundary.

46 Commissioner District #5: Sections 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 33,
47 34, 35, 36, that portion of Section 20 lying between I-90 and
48 Newport Way and those portions of Sections 29 and 32 east of
49 Newport Way and the Renton-Issaquah Road, the portion of Sections
50 21 and 28 south of I-90 and the eastern $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 22, all
51 lying within Township 24N, R6E, W.M.; together with Sections 1,
52 2, 3, 4, and that portion of Section 5 south of the Renton-
53 Issaquah Road all lying within Township 23N, R6E, W.M.

54 In general, Commissioner District #5 includes the City of
55 Issaquah and the immediate vicinity. The north boundary coincides
56 with the South boundary of Commissioner District #3. The south
57 and east boundaries coincide with the norther boundary of
58 Commissioner District #1, south to I-90 to the intersection of
59 the Issaquah-Renton Road at 196th Avenue S.E.


SECTION 7. Ordinance 5645 is hereby repealed.


