

ORDINANCE NO. 5682

AN ORDINANCE approving the Water Comprehensive Plan, 1980, for King County Water District No. 104.

PREAMBLE:

On April 20, 1981, Water District 104 passed Resolution No. 1207 which adopted the Water Comprehensive Plan, 1980.

On April 20, 1981, Water District 104 filed a Final Declaration of Non-Significance for the approval of the water comprehensive plan.

On May 22, 1981, the proposed water comprehensive plan was submitted to the Utilities Technical Review Committee for review, as required by KCC Chapter 13.24. On June 24, 1981, the Committee recommended that it be approved, subject to conditions which are contained in the UTRC Report and Recommendation (attached).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:


SECTION 1. The Water District 104 Water Comprehensive Plan, 1980, is hereby approved subject to the following:

Distribution system improvements shall be designed in accordance with the standards and requirements set forth in the hereby approved Comprehensive Plan (Chapter 5), Washington State Department of Social and Health Service regulations, and KCC 17.08 as now or hereafter amended. Further Additions and Betterments to the plan shall not require King County approval.
