

ORDINANCE NO. 5784

AN ORDINANCE, fixing rates and charges for sewerage service in County operated sewerage systems, amending Ordinance No. 1322, Section 11, and K.C.C. 13.04.100 and Ordinance No. 4608, Section 4, K.C.C. 13.04.102.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 1322, Section 11, and K.C.C. 13.04.100 are hereby amended to read as follows:

A. Fees for Permits. The fee for a permit issued as herein provided shall be ((~~thirty-five~~)) sixty dollars. Permit fee shall include the cost of the required inspection. Work shall be completed under the terms of the permit within a period of sixty calendar days. In the event that work is not completed within sixty calendar days, a new permit must be obtained and an additional fee of ((~~thirty-five~~)) sixty dollars paid.

B. Low Income Elderly Discount. The County service charge for residents of county-operated sewer systems who satisfy the criteria set forth in this section may receive a low income elderly discount of ((~~\$1.30~~)) \$2.20 applied to the county service charge portion of the base sewer rate.

C. The criteria shall be that:

1. The head of household or spouse is sixty-two years of age or older; and
2. The gross household income may not exceed ((~~\$7,833~~)) \$8,884 for a one-person household or ((~~\$10,227~~)) \$11,619 for a two-person household; and
3. Water service to the dwelling is separately metered.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 4608, Section 4, and K.C.C. 13.04.102 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Charges for Service: All property to which County-operated sewer service is available shall pay the service charges set forth in the following schedule:

1 A. The base sewer rate shall be:

2	Metro Treatment & Disposal Charge/RCE	((\$4-50))	<u>\$ 4.95</u>
3	County Service Charge/RCE	((\$5-70))	<u>\$ 6.60</u>
4	Base Sewer Rate/RCE	((\$10-20))	<u>\$11.55</u>

5 B. The base sewer rate shall be the minimum monthly charge
6 per connection for the first RCE or any portion thereof.

7 C. Charges for water used or effluent metered beyond the
8 initial 900 cubic feet shall be proportional to the quantity
9 used or metered.

10 D. Costs not included in the county portion of base sewer
11 rate and which are specific to a particular county-operated
12 sewerage system shall be as set forth below:

13 Trend ULID No. 1: The monthly service rate for
14 connections to the Trend ULID sewerage system
15 shall include the following amounts:

16	Bond maintenance & redemption	\$1.75/RCE
17	Kirkland Wheeling charge	\$0.40/RCE

18 METRO: In addition to the Metro treatment and disposal
19 charge reflected in the base sewer rate, the county shall bill
20 each customer any additional amount which the County is billed
21 by Metro for that customer.

22 E. Commercial customers served by a county operated
23 sewer system, who can demonstrate to the satisfaction of the
24 Director of Public Works and Transportation that a portion
25 of the customer's water usage does not enter the sanitary
26 sewer system may receive a reduction in the service charge.
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1 SECTION 3. The rates established in this ordinance shall
2 be effective beginning January 1, 1982.
