ORDINANCE NO. 5785

AN ORDINANCE relating to shoreline management; increasing some fees paid for processing substantial development permits, shoreline variances and shoreline redesignations; and adding a new section to Title 25.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Permits-Fee Schedule.

A. Substantial development.

The fee to be paid upon filing an application for a substantial development permit shall be based on the total cost of the proposed development, as follows:

Total Cost of Proposed Development	Fee
Up to \$100,000	\$160
\$100,001 to \$500,000	\$400
\$500,001 to \$1,000,000	\$800
More than \$1,000,000\$	1,200
A fee in the amount of one hundred dollars shall be pa	id upon
request for an extension of a permit; provided, no fee	shall be
required for King County sponsored projects.	

B. Shoreline variance.

The fee to be paid upon filing an application for a shoreline variance shall be three hundred sixty dollars.

C. Shoreline redesignation.
