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 ORDINANCE NO. 5786

AN ORDINANCE relating to fees collected for certain land use controls; increasing the fees for grading permits, short subdivisions, preliminary plats, reclassifications, unclassified use permits, and planned unit developments; amending Ordinance 3108, Section 6, and KCC 16.82.070; amending Ordinance 4606, Section 1, and KCC 19.28.060; amending Ordinance 4605, Section 1, and KCC 21.62.050.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 3108, Section 6, and KCC 16.82.070 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

Plan review and permit fees. A fee shall be paid to the director for the costs of investigation, inspection and regulation pursuant to the following schedule: (EXCEPTION: Fee shall not be required of other King County departments.)

((1)) \underline{A} . PLAN REVIEW FEES:

Plan check fee for gravel pits, landfills, cutting, filling, dumping, quarrying and mining operations, based on contour maps for the entire project, shall be paid only once. The plan review fee designated in this section shall not be required when the grading permit is to be issued for the operation of a facility authorized by an unclassified use permit.

These fees include any fees which may be required for environmental review pursuant to the State Environmental Policy Act except in those cases when an environmental impact statement is required.

((2)) B. ANNUAL OPERATING PERMIT FEES - PLATS, AREAS UNDER 18 ONE-HALF ACRE. 19 ((a)) <u>l.</u> For approved preliminary and final plats: 20 ((Five)) \$8.50 dollars per lot, minimum fee of ((twenty-five)) 21 forty-three dollars. (Plan review fees not required.) 22 23 ((b)) 2. For areas under one-half acre in size the fee is ((twenty-five)) forty-three dollars provided: 24 25 ((i)) a. No more than three thousand cubic yards of material are moved. 26 27 ((ii)) b. This ((twenty-five)) forty-three dollar fee include the cost of environmental review as required by the 28 29 State Environmental Policy Act, except in those cases when an 30

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environmental impact statement is required. 1 ((iii))c. No plan review fee is required. 2 SECTION 2. Ordinance 4606, Section 1, and KCC 19.26.040 3 are each hereby amended to read as follows: Application - Fees and expenses. ((a)) 5 6 A. APPLICATION FEE. Applications for subdivisions pursuant to this chapter shall be accompanied by fee payments to King 7 8 County in the following amounts: ((1)) 1. Short subdivision, as provided in Sections 9 10 19.26.050 through 19.26.180, ((fifty)) eighty-five doilars for the first two lots, plus ((ten)) twenty-five dollars 11 12 each additional lot; 13 ((2)) 2. Abbreviated short subdivision as set forth in 14 Section 19.26.190, ((twenty-five)) forty dollars; ((3)) 3. Revisions, as set forth in Section 19.26.200. 15 ((twenty-five)) forty dollars; 16 17 ((4)) 4. Nonbuilding short subdivision, as set forth in Section 19.26.210, ((twenty-five)) forty dollars; 18 19 ((5)) 5. All additional costs necessary 22 23 for compliance with this chapter shall be borne by the applicant. ((e)) C. FEES FOR SIGNS ON PRIVATE ROADS. Reasonable fees 24 25 may be charged by the Department of Public Works for required 26 signs. Such signs may include but not be limited to, "Fire Lane," "Private Road," "No Parking," and "Stop." 27 28 ((d)) D. RETURN OF FEES. No fee, or part of same required 29 by this title, shall be refundable for any reason. SECTION 3. Ordinance 4605, Section 1, and KCC 19.28.060 are 30 31 each hereby amended to read as follows: 32
