## ORDINANCE NO. 5796

AN ORDINANCE establishing a neighborhood parks and open space acquisition and development fund for the purpose of accounting for monies paid to King County pursuant to fees-in-lieu of land dedication as set forth in Ordinance No. 5596.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Creation: There is created a capital project fund entitled "The neighborhood parks and open space acquisition and development fund".

SECTION 2. Purpose: The purpose of this fund shall be to account for and disburse monies paid to King County for fees-in-lieu of land dedication and open space purposed. All disbursements from this fund shall be to support projects authorized by Ordinance including joint projects as established by inter-local agreement.

SECTION 3. Organization: The fund shall be structured in such a way as to permit accounting for revenues and expenditures by school districts.

SECTION 4. Investment: Any monies in the fund not currently needed shall be invested by the comptroller as provided by law. Proceeds of said investments shall be
