ORDINANCE NO. 5804

AN ORDINANCE disincorporating and dissolving Lake Burien Donahue District No. 14, a road district, pursuant to RCW 36.96 and specifying the manner in which it is to be accomplished.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Findings and Statement of Fact. The County

Council, having held a hearing on the 2/5+ day of Security.

19/8/1 pursuant to RCW 36.96.030 and proper notice having

been given of said hearing and testimony and/or evidence having

been received finds that:

- A. The comptroller of King County has on file no records of any disbursements or deposits or any other financial evidence of any activity by Lake Burien Donahue District No. 14 in the past five years.
- B. RCW 36.96 allows the County Council to disincorporate a special purpose district on its own initiative, if any such district appears to meet the criteria by being "inactive" as defined in the chapter.
- C. The Lake Burien Donahue District No. 14 has not actively carried out the special purposes or functions for which it was formed within the preceding five-year period, nor has it held elections for the purpose of electing a member of the governing body within the preceding seven-year period.
- D. King County Resolution 20209 of August 31, 1959 was passed regarding the destruction of certain listed obsolete public records, permission for which was received from the Bureau of Municipal Corporations, the Attorney General's Office and the State archivist. Records pertaining to the Lake Burien Donahue District were affected by the resolution. Legal boundaries are not contained herein due to prior distruction of documents.
- E. Lake Burien Donahue District No. 14 merely adds to the number of special use districts, and the best interests of the citizens of the County will be served by disincorporation, thereby

eliminating a nonfunctioning and unnecessary special unit of government.

SECTION 2. Order of Disincorporation. Based on the findings set forth in Section 1, Lake Burien Donahue District No. 14 is hereby disincorporated

SECTION 3. Supervision of Liquidation of Assets. The King County Executive or his designee is hereby directed to supervise and administer the exchange, sale, or other means of disposal of any assets, and the satisfaction of any outstanding indebtedness of Lake Burien Donahue District No. 14 in accordance with RCW 36.96.060 on behalf of the King County Council.

- A. King County Fund Number 04-014-8010 Lake Burien Donahue District shows a cash balance of \$1,000.00 and \$1,000.00 in bonds outstanding.
- B. The sale or disposal of any assets of the district shall be accomplished in the manner provided in KCC 4.56, to the extent practicable. If such transfer is feasible, the King County Executive or his designee shall transfer property necessary to the construction, existence or management of this drainage system to the governmental unit which succeeds this district in its operation and management.

SECTION 4. Distribution of assets and assessments to cover costs and expenses of liquidation.

- A. Pursuant to RCW 36.96.070 the monies on hand in the treasury of the District and any remaining real property or improvements, shall, after payment of all costs and expenses of liquidation incurred by the County and all outstanding indebtedness become the property of King County.
- B. In the event the monies on hand in its treasury are insufficient to retire any outstanding indebtedness together with all costs and expenses of liquidation, the County Executive is authorized to prepare and submit to the County Council an assessment levy for enactment in the manner provided by law. Said levy

shall be against the property in the District and in amounts sufficient to retire any outstanding indebtedness and such costs and expenses as may be incurred by the County in the liquidation proceeding. The King County Executive shall by July 1,1982 report to the County Council an accounting of the distribution of assets and the satisfaction of any outstanding indebtedness of Lake Burien Donahue District No. 14.
