## ORDINANCE NO. 5815

AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$100,000 to the Solid Waste Operating Fund from the Metro Sludge Reserve Fund balance; amending Ordinance No. 5232, Section 69, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$100,000 to the Solid Waste Operating Fund from the Metro Sludge Reserve Fund balance to finance extraordinary expenses for servicing the sludge pits at the Cedar Hills Sanitary Landfill.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 5232, Section 69, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the Solid Waste Fund there is hereby appropriated:
