ORDINANCE NO. 5844

AN ORDINANCE approving an Amendment to Water District No. 108 Water Comprehensive Plan providing for services to an area lying outside the district's boundary known as the "East Service Area" (Resolution No. 1637) and declaring an emergency.

PREAMBLE:

On June 17, 1981, Water District No. 108 adopted Resolution No. 1637 amending Resolution No. 18 (as amended) providing for additions and betterments to the original water comprehensive plan to serve a portion of the "East Service Area" lying outside of the district's boundary under contracts with property owners.

On September 9, 1981, Water District No. 108 adopted Resolution No. 1660 concurring with the Threshold Determination of Non-Significance of the district's water system improvement.

The Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed amendment as required by KCC 13.24 and Ordinance No. 4146, and on October 14, 1981, recommended its approval subject to certain conditions pursuant to Ordinance No. 4146.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The amendment to the Water District No. 108 Water Comprehensive Plan as adopted by District Resolution No.1637

1 is hereby approved subject to certain conditions pursuant to
2 Ordinance No. 4146 and subject to the following limitations:

3 A. Service to properties north of State Highway SR 18 is
4 not approved because they are outside of the service area
5 permitted by Ordinance No. 4146.

6 B. Service to properties south of State Highway SR 18 is
7 authorized for those properties specifically requesting
8 services pursuant to Water District No. 108 Resolution 1637, and
9 for those properties lying south of SR 18 which are presently
10 served by the Nob Hill Water Company.
