- 2. The Department of Public Works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements are not required.
- 3. The Division of Building & Land Development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and they recommend that the request be denied. They reasoned "The right of way should remain in order to provide future access to property to the north (Snohomish County) and become a part of the neighborhood circulation system." The Department of Public Works has contacted Snohomish County and were advised that there were no plans for a connecting road because of the swampy condition in the area. This coincides with King County's engineering staff reports.
- 4. The vacation area is a portion of the plat of Lake Margaret recorded July 1, 1958. The Department of Public Works has found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of their records indicates that the County has spent no funds for its acquisition or maintenance. Right of way, therefore, should be classified "C Class" in accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. The Department of Public Works considers the remaining subject right of way useless as part of the County road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
