## STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a 10 foot Drainage Easement, McLane's Garden Tracts, hereinafter described.
- 2. The Department of Public Works has notified the various utilities serving the area and advises that no utilities are involved in the vacation area.
- 3. The Division of Building & Land Development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. The vacation area is a right of way easement for a drainage culvert pipe located on Lots 10 and 11, McLane's Garden Tracts, granted to King County, Washington by instrument dated August 4, 1970 and recorded under Auditor's File No. 6678979 (Volume 428 of Deeds, pages 18 and 19). A search of the Public Works records indicate that the County has spent no funds for its acquisition or maintenance. Right of way would, therefore, be classified "C" Class.
- 5. The Department of Public Works considers the remaining subject Drainage Easement useless as part of the County Drainage System.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the 8 mm day of m 198m .
