AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of Ed Botsford Road, County Road No. 180 Petitioner: Vernon S. Mills and Others V - 1743

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of Ed Botsford Road, County Road No. 180, hereinafter described.
- The Department of Public Works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements are not required.
- The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- The vacation area is a portion of County Road No. 180, named the Ed Botsford Road when established by King County on November 6, 1886. Old aerial photos, prior to 1936, distinctly show this road on the ground. However, we could find no record that the County has spent funds for its acquisition or maintenance. Right of way would, therefore, be classified "C" Class in accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759.
- The Department of Public Works considers the remaining subject right of way useless as part of the County road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the 8th, day of Much, 1982.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Council on the 8th day of march, 19 82, hereby vacates and abandons the portion of Ed Botsford Road, County Road No. 180, described as follows:
