ORDINANCE NO. 5905

AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of Park Boulevard. Petitioner: King County Department of Public Works V-1770

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of Park Boulevard, hereinafter described.
- 2. The Department of Public Works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements were not required.
- 3. The Department of Public Works requests the vacation of a parcel of land in the Plat of Woodmont Beach. This portion of land was deeded to King County and recorded under Auditor's File No. 1620442 (Vol. 1175 of Deeds, page 263) on May 29, 1922 for reasons unknown but assumed to be part of Park Boulevard within the Plat of Woodmont Beach. Title to the remaining or larger portion of the platted lot has described the King County portion "for road purposes," subsequent to the deed to King County. This Department has investigated the deeded area in the same procedure utilized in the vacation process.
- 4. The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 5. On October 14, 1924 the King County Commissioners, having been petitioned, vacated the portion of Park Boulevard located adjacent to the subject area and made no mention of this deeded area. Records of the Department of Assessments show the area as the property of Duane Nienader who has advised us he has paid taxes on the land for over 20 years. A perpetual easement agreement recorded in King County Records under Auditor's File No. 5624563 (Vol. 4442 of Deeds, page 401) grants access over the existing driveway leading to Lots 4 and 5 which lie south of this subject area. This indenture is recognized in the legal description.
- 6. It appears to have been through oversight that the area was not included in that vacation. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance.
