STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of 30th Avenue S.W. hereinafter described.
- 2. The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 3. The Department of Public Works notified the various utilities serving the area and was advised that easements are not required. The Seattle Water Department has received \$1,000.00 for abandonment of their 6" watermain in the vacation area and the reconnection of two affected water services.
- 4. The owner of Lot 21 built a garage which extended onto the right of way. The vacation area described herein is intended to clear the encroachment by one foot on all three sides of the garage. The plat in which the vacation area is located was recorded on March 12, 1963. The County has maintained 30th Avenue S.W. since that time. Right of way would, therefore, be classified "B Class" in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759. King County is now in receipt of \$715.00 from the petitioner which has been judged to be the just compensation to King County for this vacation area.
- 5. The Department of Public Works considers the subject vacation area useless as part of the County road system and believes that the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the 84h day of 2000, 1982.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the Council has determined that is is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
