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ORDINANCE NO. 5913

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as 15th Avenue Annexation to King County Water District No. 56.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as 15th Avenue Annexation to King County Water District No. 56 was filed with the County Council effective February 19, 1982.

2. King County Water District No. 56 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 296 concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 56 filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated January 6, 1982, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 15th day of March, 19 82, and has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 56 known as 15th Avenue Annexation and described in Section 3 herein is approved. King County Council annexation Report on 15th Avenue Annexation is attached and made a part of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.

SECTION 3. The area known as 15th Avenue Annexation to be annexed is described as follows:

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Lots 1 through 10 of Block 39 of the plat of "Woodmont Beach" as filed in Volume 22 of Plats, Page 30, Records of King County, Washington;

TOGETHER WITH the North half of Virginia Road (also known as South 270th Street) as shown on said plat, lying Southerly of the Westerly extension of the Southerly line of said Lot 10 and lying Westerly of the Southerly extension of the Easterly line of said Lot 10 and lying Easterly of the centerline of Woodhurst Avenue (also known as 15th Avenue South);

ALSO TOGETHER WITH the East half of said Woodhurst Avenue, also known as 15th Avenue South, as shown on said plat, lying Southerly of the Westerly extension of the Northerly line of Lot 1 of said plat and lying Northerly of the Westerly extension of the Southerly line of said Lot 10;

ALSO TOGETHER WITH the South half of Lynden Road (also known as South 268th Street) as shown on said plat, lying Northerly of the Westerly extension of the Northerly line of said Lot 1 and lying Easterly of the centerline of said Woodhurst Avenue (also known as 15th Avenue South) and lying Westerly of the Northerly extension of the Easterly line of said Lot 1.
