STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of an alley between South 212th Street and South 213th Street, hereinafter described.
- 2. The Department of Public Works has notified the various utilities serving the area and was advised that easements are not required.
- 3. The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. The vacation area is a 15-foot wide alley in the plat of the Southern Pacific Land Company's Second Addition to Des Moines. The Department of Public Works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended in its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. Right of way would, therefore, be classified "C" Class in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
