ORDINANCE NO. 5938

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AN ORDINANCE concurring with the Recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying certain property upon the application of ROBERT GOOCH, ET AL, designated Building and Land Development File No. 110-82-R.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This Ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the March 17, 1982, report of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, filed with the Clerk of the Council on April 1, 1982, on the application of ROBERT GOOCH, ET AL, to reclassify certain property described in Building and Land Development File No. 110-82-R.

SECTION 2. The recommendation by the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to reclassify the subject property from SR (7200) (Potential RD 3600-P) to RD 3600-P in lieu of RD 3600, subject to pre-effective and post-effective conditions (modified), is hereby adopted by the Council of King County. Those conditions, if any which must be satisfied before this ordinance become effective must be satisfied on or before December 31, 1982, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effective. (If none, the effective date shall be ten days after enactment.) Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the Building and Land Development Division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
