AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of South 296th Street Petitioner: David J. Rhodes and Others V-1769

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of South 296th Street, hereinafter described.
- 2. The Department of Public Works has notified the various utilities serving the areas and has been advised that easements have been secured by Puget Sound Power and Light Company, Pacific Northwest Bell Company and Washington Natural Gas Company.
- 3. The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. The vacation area is a portion of the plat of Hall's Acre Tracts, which was recorded on October 2, 1911. We found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a public road. A search of the records indicate that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The road is, therefore, classified "C" Class in accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. The Division of Planning recommended denial of the vacation, stating that the right of way is a heavily used pedestrian trail access to SR 99. The petitioner, who was advised of this recommendation, has written to inform us of his promise to landscape and install a 15 foot walkway with railroad tie stairway for access to 18th Avenue South from Pacific Highway South. The area is zoned for commercial use and the pedestrian stairway will permit access from the east. A copy of his letter is enclosed with the petition.
- 6. The Department of Public Works considers the remaining subject right of way useless as part of the County road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
