ORDINANCE NO. 5950

AN ORDINANCE approving the City of Auburn's Water Comprehensive Plan Amendment (Resolution No. 1286).

PREAMBLE:

On January 18, 1982, the City of Auburn adopted Resolution No. 1286 which provides for additions and betterments to the City's 1977 Water Comprehensive Plan.

On February 16, 1982, the City of Auburn adopted Resolution No. 27 concurring in Threshold Determination of Negative Impact on adoption of the City's water system comprehensive plan amendment.

On February 3, 1982, the proposed amendment was submitted to the Utilities Technical Review Committee for review, as required by KCC Chapter 13.24. On February 24, 1982, the Committee recommended its approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The proposed amendment to the City of Auburn's Water Comprehensive Plan, as adopted by district Resolution No. 1286 (attached) is hereby approved.
