

ORDINANCE NO. 5951

AN ORDINANCE relating to a "No Shooting Area" established by King County Ordinance 474 and K.C.C. 12.68.420 and granting a conditional exemption.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

PREAMBLE:

The purpose of this Ordinance is to grant an exemption from the provisions of King County Ordinance 474 and K.C.C. 12.68.420 which established a "No Shoot Area" within one-half mile of the Renton-Maple Valley Road (SR 169) from the City of Renton to the Cedar Mountain Bridge.

SECTION 1. Exemption. The following exemptions shall apply to the "No Shooting Area" as specified in Ordinance 474 and K.C.C. 12.68.420 with the following conditions:

A. Shooting shall be allowed only on the property commonly known as "Riley's Aqua Barn Ranch".

B. The type of shooting to be allowed shall be muzzleloading, black powder type rifles and handguns.

C. All shooting shall occur only during the following days and hours:

1. May 29, 1982 - 9:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.

2. May 30, 1982 - 11:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.

3. May 31, 1982 - 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 noon.

D. All shooting shall be done at least five-hundred feet (500') from the Maple Valley Road (SR 169).

E. Shooting activities shall be supervised by an active Black Powder Rifle and Sportsman's Club member.
